

Bonin Field Concession Stand Information

Updated Spring 2017

General Information

Please open Concession Stand at least 20 minutes BEFORE your game starts. Head Coaches will unlock the stand for you, and provide the team cash box. If the stand is unlocked, an Adult should be in the stand from that time forward! To serve, handle, or sell alcoholic beverages, one must be 18 years or older. No exceptions, this is the Law and it must be adhered! You have the right to refuse service to anyone, if there is an issue with someone over-consuming alcohol, please advise your Head Coach who in turn should advise an SPAA Board Member.

Before the Game:

- 1) **Ensure the Head Coach has unlocked and cleaned the Restrooms.** Extra soaps & paper products can be found in the Concession Stand. Any major issues, please alert Mike/Mandy.
- 2) Feel free to move the money from your team's Cash Box and put in the Concession money drawer for easier use. The money drawer is to stay in the stand at all times. When done with your game, move the money from the drawer back to the Cash Box. The Cash Box goes back to your Head Coach.
- 3) Most fridges and freezer are labeled with items located within.
- 4) Prep Hot Dogs – wipe out skillet, put water in (using a bottle of water), heat water to boil, add hot dogs which are found in the freezer or fridge.
- 5) Take hot dog buns out of fridge/freezer – use microwave to thaw if needed (located on shelf in NW corner of building)
- 6) Serve hot dogs in hot dog boats with a napkin, or just a napkin. Boats are located on back shelf.
- 7) Place condiments/napkins on concession window ledge.
- 8) Nacho Cheese – turn on warmer, put cheese cups in the warmer if not already in it. Serve using a nacho plastic container, located near the nacho warmer, by providing a cup of cheese and a bag of nacho chips.
- 9) Popcorn – start making via instructions on the machine. Typically one or two packs per game. Popcorn boxes are next to the machine, and packets of kernels/salt/butter are located next to machine.
- 10) Pizzas – located in the freezer. **Please cook only when one is ordered; do not pre-cook.** Unwrap and keep the cardboard bottom aside. Place pizza in pizza oven and turn timer to about 10 minutes. Keep an eye on it as the timing will vary. When done, slide out of oven and onto the saved cardboard bottom. Use the pizza cutter to cut into slices; provide paper plates/napkins to the patron, and serve on cardboard bottom.

- 11) Peanuts – take a 12 oz. cup and fill with peanuts in the shell to serve. Close bag when done.
- 12) Stock the fridges if needed with beverages; stock the chips and candy if needed
- 13) Garbage Cans – make sure they have been put out – place in green garbage bin holders near the trees and near equipment shed or where necessary for fans to utilize.
- 14) Checks are accepted for purchases; they should be written to St. Patrick Athletic Association.

After the Game:

- 1) Umpires – pay the ump (\$115/game for Irish, \$85 for Shamrocks, \$50 for T&C/Majors, \$40 for Pee Wee/Midgets), and give them free Water/Gatorade. If questions about payment, ask your Head Coach.
- 2) Hot Dogs – clean out skillet, dump water outside in the grass, use soap and bottled water to clean the skillet and wipe dry, put the cover on when done, clean utensils. If unsold cooked Hot Dogs, place in plastic bags in fridge, or sell at reduced price (so long as there aren't a ton left).
- 3) Popcorn – clean via instructions on machine. Use a paper towel to wipe down the inside. If extra, box and keep within the machine.
- 4) Nachos – turn off the warmer.
- 5) Put condiments back in fridge.
- 6) Re-stock the fridges if needed with beverages, candy, other items as needed. Put items where they belong per labels on the fridges. This ensures items are cold for the next day's game(s).
- 7) Garbage – empty garbages into the dumpster near the restrooms and put cans under the pavilion area between concession stand and equipment room.
- 8) Bathrooms – clean up, lock up, and throw away any garbage
- 9) If you are low on certain bills or coins, please let Mike or Mandy know. They will get more to your Head Coach.
- 10) Sweep the floor of any messes – please leave the Stand as you found it – or better**
- 11) Ensure Head Coach has locked all doors on the premises!!**

If you run out of something, or feel we are low on inventory of an item(s), please let Mike or Mandy know. Inventories are checked nearly every day.
